

Seasonal Mosquito Surveillance Technician Mosquito Abatement District- Davis

Job Description:

The Seasonal Mosquito Surveillance Technician works with the lab manager to run the population surveillance trap program in Davis County. Work includes daily monitoring and maintenance of CDC traps. Will be expected to learn about integrated mosquito management and apply it to their work. Will be expected to work in the field for much of the day, an ideal position for a detail-oriented self-starter.

Basic Duties:

- Monitors and picks up population monitoring traps daily through the week.
- Accurately records data on each trap.
- Repairs and maintains all mosquito surveillance traps.
- Simple “housekeeping” tasks, and simple equipment maintenance.
- Attends training sessions, reads district manuals, and otherwise keeps informed of policies and procedures; keeps lab manager informed of progress and problems.

Qualifications:

- Education equivalent to graduation from high school.
- Must possess a valid Utah driver’s license with an excellent driving record.
- Ability to obtain a Utah pesticide applicators license in the first week after hire.
- Must be physically able and willing to do physical labor. Must be willing and able to lift fifty pounds.
- Must have the ability to safely operate district equipment
- Must be able to work dependably, cooperatively with others and to exercise independent judgement

Job Duration:

April 1 to October 1, 40 hours/week, Monday through Friday.
