

Job Description

Seasonal/Part Time Mosquito Control Technician

Definition:

Under close supervision, conducts routine assignments in adult mosquito control and to do work as required. The Seasonal/Part Time Mosquito Control Technician is a seasonal employee hired for the summer mosquito control season.

Characteristics:

The Seasonal/Part Time Mosquito Control Technician works during the evening hours and conducts adult mosquito control efforts in their assigned area. Must be able to study for and pass the Pesticide Applicators test given by the Utah Department of Agriculture. Will gain a working knowledge of the mosquito control product being used by the District. Will gain a working knowledge of mosquito life stages, and proper application techniques of adult mosquito treatment.

Examples of Duties:

- Operates ULV adult mosquito control equipment at dusk until 12:00-1:00am. Works with “On Call” supervisor to treat assigned spray blocks.
- Records all treatments and maintains accurate records of wind, temperature, and treatments of special request.
- Help in set up and the collection of mosquito surveillance traps.
- Simple truck cleaning tasks, and simple equipment maintenance.
- Assist in calibration of various pieces of spray equipment as needed.
- Attends training sessions, reads District manuals, and otherwise keeps informed of policies and procedures; keeps Assistant Manager informed of progress and problems.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Education equivalent to graduation from high school.
- Must possess a valid Utah Driver’s License with an excellent driving record.
- Must be physically able and willing to do physical labor. Must be willing and able to lift fifty pounds.
- Must have the ability to safely operate district equipment
- Must be able to work dependably, cooperatively with others and to exercise independent judgement
